CRUNCH AND SIP

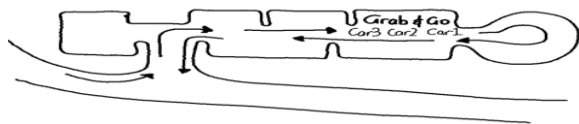
Our school is participating in the Crunch and Sip Program. We feel it is very important that growing children understand the importance of a healthy diet and exercise. Hence, as part of this initiative, children are to bring a piece of fruit or vegetable for eating during crunch and sip which is usually in the morning.

This also ensures children have the energy to stay alert and concentrate through the morning.

For our younger grades we suggest fruits and vegetables to be washed and cut in bite size pieces.

We also urge parents to pack a healthy lunchbox that includes sandwiches, fruits and vegetables. Please avoid packaged foods such as chips and lollies as they are high in salt, sugar and contain additives and preservatives. Also many children suffer from nut allergies, therefore **DO NOT pack nuts or nut products such as peanuts, peanut butter or Nutella**

CARPARK MATTERS



- Cars must reverse park at all times.
- Left turn into the car park permitted only.
- 30 second time limit at the pickup/ drop off zone. (Driver must not leave the vehicle)
- 10km/h speed limit
- Always use zebra crossing

Failure to follow these guidelines puts the lives of our students and families at risk. Please remember that our school is private property and is protected under the Inclosed Lands Act which includes schools.

We strongly suggest that students younger than 10 years of age not walk to their cars but be picked up from the waiting area by an adult or older sibling.

UNIFORM MATTERS

Please ensure your child comes to school each and every day in full school uniform. This includes a school blazer except on sports days with polished black shoes. Students must also have an official Malek Fahd School Bag. Sports uniform can only be worn on Sports Days and includes fully enclosed running joggers for students. A reminder that boys can only wear the 3/4 shorts during Terms 1 & 4. They must wear the full tracksuit during Terms 2&3. The primary sports day is Thursday. High School students will be advised on which days to wear their sports uniform this week.

FRIDAY ASSEMBLY

This Friday 2 February, there will be a K-12 Assembly starting at 8:45am in the Primary School Hall. The Years K-6 Assembly will commence from next Friday where students will be presented with awards for their behavior and achievement.
