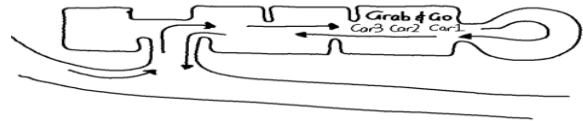
This also ensures children have the energy to stay alert and concentrate through the morning.
