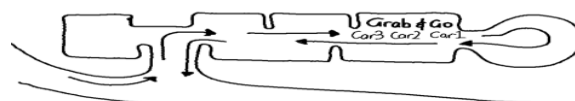
NATIONAL DAY OF ACTION AGAINST BULLYING AND VIOLENCE
