National Bullying Prevention Week

Anti-Bullying Prevention Week is taking place from 15-19 of November 2021 (week 7). The theme for this year is 'One Kind Word'. We would like to spread a serious message behind the fun; let's pull on odd socks to show we are ALL unique and different, and let's be kind to each other and respect each other's individuality. Children are to wear odd socks to school on Monday 15 November. Please encourage students to wear their "odd" socks to show their support towards anti-bullying.

Primary students will also have a fun mufti day on Friday 19 November.

If your **child is sick, they must not attend school**. If your child has a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, they should stay home, even if the symptoms are mild. Unwell children at school will be isolated and parents will need to pick them up.

CANTEEN: Please be reminded that students who do not preorder recess/lunch **will not be served** at the canteen. All orders must be made at home and placed in the classroom lunch basket before 9am. This is applicable to both primary and secondary students.

To ensure that we continue to provide a safe environment it is important that we strictly abide by the following requests.

- Wearing of Mask - All adults and Secondary students of Years 7 to 12 will be required to wear a mask at all times (indoors and outdoors), with the exception of when they are eating. The wearing of masks will reduce the risk of transmission.
- If your child has a certified medical condition that prevents mask wearing, please contact the Campus to advise them of the condition.
- Social distancing must be strictly adhered to.
- Parents are required to drop and pick up their child at the Campus gate.
- Parents are not allowed to walk their child to the Office.
- Parents must not to gather and socialise on Campus premises.
- Parents are asked not to park and get out of their car.
- It is essential that all students are collected on time.
- All meetings between staff and parents will take place via phone or virtually.

- QR Codes and Check in: All persons coming on site is required to check in via the Service NSW QR Code. Please ensure that you check out on departure.

It is essential that everyone maintains good hygiene practices:

- Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds at regular intervals throughout the day.
- Hand washing is essential before and after eating and after going to the toilet.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with the inside of the elbow or a tissue.
- Place used tissues straight into the bin.
- Avoid touching the eyes, nose and mouth.
- Do not share food or drink.

To further reduce transmission risk, each student is to bring their **own water bottle** instead of using the bubblers at school.
