Year 10 Excursion to Wanda beach in Cronulla

Our Year 10 students, combined with Beaumont Hills students, visited Wanda beach in Cronulla on 23rd March and investigated coastal processes by measuring and studying elements of a natural/re-established sand dune, such as size and shape, vegetation type and cover and wind speed. Identification of landforms and examination of land use in the surrounding areas were also undertaken using aerial photographs and cadastral maps. Historical photographs were used to examine the effects of human development and storm erosion processes on the sand dunes. Detailed investigation of past and present management strategies was also undertaken.
