RESUME WRITING AND INTERVIEW WORKSHOPS



UNIFORM MATTERS

CARPARK MATTERS



- Cars must reverse park at all times.
- ➤ 30 second time limit at the pickup/ drop off zone. (Driver must not leave the vehicle)
- > 10km/h speed limit
- Always use zebra crossing (Do not walk across the carpark)
- > 'NO STOPPING' area at the roundabout.
