INCIDENT IN CAR PARK YESTERDAY

You may be aware of an incident in the car park yesterday afternoon about 20 minutes before the end of the school day. At 2.50pm, a P-plated motor vehicle entered the car park well over the speed limit, narrowly missing a parent walking on the School crossing. Upon exiting the car park, the vehicle stopped at the street. When our security guard and the parent approached the car, he sped off. The incident lasted no more than a minute.

Children were at all times safe and were not in the area. They were in class. The parent, who was with our security guard at the time, notified police after the driver sped off. The vehicle's description and its registration plate number were given to police. Police went to the driver's home this morning and interviewed him. It was not considered necessary to initiate the School's emergency response procedures, which includes a lock-down as the driver had immediately left the School campus. The School gate was unlocked at 3.10pm and children were dismissed from School at 3.10pm.

As is the case after any incident, we will review this incident and our response to ensure that we continue to provide a safe and secure environment for everyone in our School.
