Campus Developments

There is ongoing significant amount of work undertaken across all three campuses. Some of the classrooms have been or are in the process of being re-carpeted. Additional new air conditioners have been installed in Greenacre Primary. Hoxton Park and Beaumont Hills campuses both had new turf laid.

Mobile Phones

The misuse of mobile phones has the potential to adversely impact the wellbeing and learning outcomes

of our students. As such, to ensure a safe learning environment for all students, the school has a **zero tolerance approach** towards the use of mobile phones by students. Under no circumstances are students permitted to use mobile phones inside school grounds. They must be switched off and placed in their bags or lockers. In the event that a student is caught with, or using a mobile phone, the phone will be confiscated for the day, the student will receive an afterschool detention and parents/guardians will be called to collect the device. If the same student is caught using a mobile phone a second time, they will receive a second afterschool detention and this will automatically lead to an internal suspension. The device will also be confiscated for one week and parents/guardians will be notified to collect the device.

Contact with parents in the event of illness or other urgent matter will be managed through the school office after a student has been referred to or attended the sick bay for treatment or assistance. Should a parent need to contact their child during school hours, they must do so through the front office, and should not contact the student's phone. We look forward to your cooperation.
