Ease of Restrictions

With the easing of COVID-19 restrictions, I am delighted to announce that schools are able to recommence the majority of school-based activities. The daily congregational Zuhr prayers commenced this week across all campuses. School assemblies and incursions have resumed. The Beaumont Hills campus held their first post COVID-19 assembly on Monday, which I was very excited to be part of.

HSC Trial

On 15 June, an email was sent to all Year 12 parents regarding the HSC Trials with the timetable attached and important information about preparations for these examinations. The trial examinations will take place in Weeks 6 and 7 of Term 3.

2021 Subject Selection

At the start of Term 3, Year 8 and Year 10 students will be asked to submit their subject preferences for Year 9 electives and Year 11 subjects. In order to provide information to students and parents, Mr Hamper – the Deputy Principal Teaching and Learning and Mrs Bragg – the Secondary Curriculum Coordinator will be conducting information sessions. With the need for social distancing these events will take place online and parents will also be sent the presentation materials afterwards. These sessions will run for all campuses and will be conducted using Microsoft Teams, which is an online tool that does not require you to download any programs as long as you have internet access. The link to the Teams sessions will run out of any standard web browser.

For 2021 Year 9, the information session will take place on Monday, 29 June at 6pm. Parents of current Year 8 students will be sent an email with a link to access the session ahead of the meeting.

For 2021 Year 11, the information session will take on Wednesday, 1 July at 6pm. Parents of current Year 10 students will be sent an email with a link to access the session ahead of the meeting.
