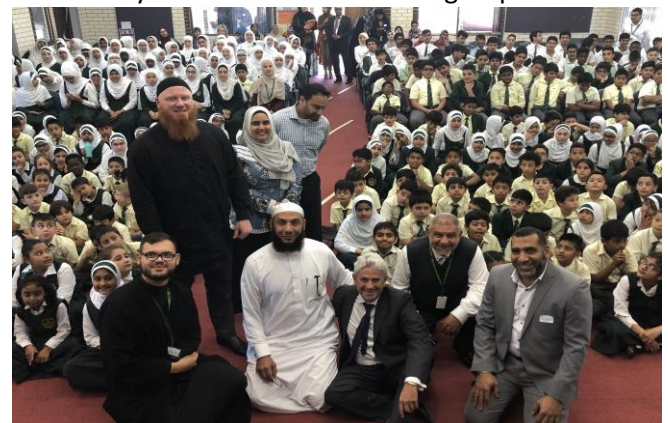
LMA Teachers Appreciation Award Ceremony

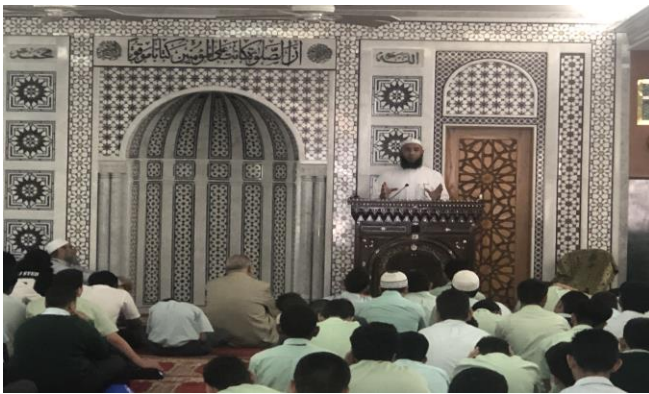

School Uniform
