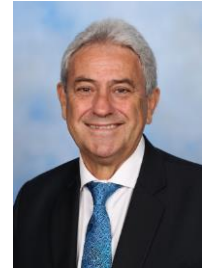

It was an exciting time this week to welcome all our students back to full time class on Wednesday. We all missed you. I have had the pleasure of seeing the joyous faces of students at each campus. They are all excited to be back at school with their friends, their teachers, and back into a new “normal” school return. I continue to thank all staff and my executive team and laud them for their extraordinary work during this very difficult time with COVID-19.

I also extend my thanks and praise to all parents for their support and patience during this time. I completely understand the difficulty of negotiating education from home. We are all in this together and you have been most remarkable in your response to this most extra-ordinary time.

I want to commend parents of the three campuses of the drop-off process. It is simply parents dropping their child at the school gate and leaving. We will continue this process, so children do not alight into potential traffic, I request you pick and drop your child from the left side of the car.

On Wednesday, at the Greenacre Campus, there was significant over-crowding of parents as they awaited eagerly to pick up their children. I remind all that we are still in COVID-19 restrictions. For the safety of staff and the children, it is essential that parents abide by the Health Department and NSW Premier’s directions. As a result of parents over-crowding on Wednesday, yesterday I was forced to make a change to the ending time of Kindergarten and their siblings, and Year 1 and their siblings. The change went well. I know that it is difficult for your personal and work arrangements, and I thank parents for their patience and consideration of staff, students, and other parents.

### Staggered start and finish time for Greenacre Campus:

- Kindergarten to Year Six will commence at 9.00am
- Secondary students will commence at 8.30am
- 2.30pm finish for Kindergarten and siblings
- 2.45pm finish for Year 1 and siblings
- 3.00pm finish for Year 2 and siblings
- 3.15pm finish for Years 3 – 6 and siblings
- 3.30pm finish for all Secondary

### Staggered start and finish time for Hoxton Park and Beaumont Hills campuses:

- Kindergarten to Year Six will commence at 9.00am.
- Secondary students will commence at 8.30am
- 3.00pm finish for Kindergarten, Years 1 and 2 and their siblings
- 3.15pm finish for Year 3 to Year 6 and siblings
- 3.30pm finish for all Secondary
