Dear Parents and Carers, Assalamu alaykum wa ruhmatullahi wa barakaatuhu



Canteen

All recess and lunch orders must be placed in the morning. Students are still not permitted to line up to purchase food from the canteen. Please be reminded that canteen will be **closed this Thursday 30 July**. Students should bring packed recess and lunch from home.

Important Message to Parents

- Sick students must not attend school. They must stay home until they are free from symptoms.
- 2. Maintain physical distancing from other parents and teachers.
- 3. Drop off students at the carline in the morning. Parents will not be allowed to walk their children to the classroom.
- 4. Parents must wait inside their cars during carline.

Attendance

The Education Act (1990) states that it is the duty of the parent of a child of compulsory school-age to cause the child to be enrolled at, and to attend, ... school, or to be registered for home schooling. Parents are required to **explain the absences** of their children from school promptly and **within seven days** to the school.

Please remember that the explanation of the absence is your legal responsibility and as such you must respond to the text message you receive when your child is away from school. If the reason is other than sickness, then it is your responsibility to fill out a Leave Form.

UNIFORM MATTERS
