This is a great way to celebrate the end of high school for our Year 12 students. The Presentation Day will be held on Wednesday 18 November at the Quay Centre in Homebush. All Year 12 students must report to the Campus by 8:00am. Students are not to arrive at the venue with parents, however, may leave with parents after the assembly.

The Campus community was emailed the NSW Health media alert last night. As per the email, traces of the virus has been detected at the Rouse Hill Treatment plant. Carpark Matters

- Cars must always reverse park. No parking is permitted in the morning.

- 10km/h speed limit
- Always use zebra crossing (Do not walk across the carpark)
- 'NO STOPPING' at the roundabout.

- Students must only enter car or exit at Car Space 1, 2, 3, 4 or in cars parked in designated car spaces.

Please follow the directions of the security personnel to ensure the safety of all users. Failure to follow these guidelines puts the lives of our students and families at risk.

Important Message to Parents

1. Sick students must not attend school. They must stay home until they are free from symptoms and/or negative Covid-10 test result.
2. Maintain physical distancing from other parents and teachers.
3. Drop off students at the carline in the morning. Parents will not be allowed to walk their children to the classroom.
4. Parents must wait inside their cars during carline.
5. Parents must not gather or socialise on Campus grounds.
6. Parents must have an appointment to see a staff member. No walk-ins permitted. Phone and email preferred.
7. Students must bring a filled water bottle from home.
8. Parents should speak to their children about avoiding close contact with their friends and regular handwashing.
9. Students must have a recess and/or lunch order from home. Students will not be permitted to line up and purchase food from the canteen.
