School Uniform 2021

Please ensure you have made an appointment to purchase your child's uniform for next year. It is important that all students come to school in their full school uniform which includes a blazer to be worn during Term 2 and Term 3 and during special assemblies and events. Students who do not wear their full school uniform will be placed on detention and continued failure to wear the full uniform may mean further disciplinary action. Students **will not be permitted to participate** in the assemblies and events without full uniform.

- Students must wear the permitted shoes only.
- Students out of uniform must have a very good reasons otherwise they will be placed on detention.
- Boys must wear ties
- Girls in Years K-6 must wear the instant School scarf sold through the Uniform Shop only. No pins allowed.
- High School girls must pin their scarf under the chin.
- Only school coloured socks and stocking allowed. Wearing mismatched tights and socks not permitted.
- Uniform must be clean and ironed
- Torn uniform must be replaced
- Hair Style – no undercuts. Hair must be one level.
- Students must have a hat to participate in sports and outdoor activities.

Punctuality

Students who are late to school 3 times in a term will be placed on detention. Primary students must be in class by 8:45am and high school students by 8:25am. It is ideal that students arrive at least 15 minutes before start time. Supervision is provided at the Campus from 8:10am each day.

Behaviour Expectation at the School

As a student of Malek Fahd, all students are expected to demonstrate acceptable behaviour. Students who demonstrate unacceptable behaviour or fail to follow teacher instructions will face the consequences. Students must always be respectful towards others and the school property. Vandalism, disrespect towards staffed peers and bullying will not be tolerated.

On the first day back next year all high school students should proceed to the high school building. New students in Years 1-10 should report to the front office and will be guided to their classroom.

Kindergarten 2021 students will be met with teachers in the foyer at 9:00am on Friday 29 January 2021. It is an expectation that parents will say their goodbyes and leave promptly. Please teach your child to carry their own bags and belongings. Thank you.
