- Demonstrate creativity, innovation and flexibility in their approach to the provision of library services
- Demonstrate a user-orientated approach to library service provision
- Demonstrated ability to use a range of technologies, including e-books for the provision of information and library services
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment with relational ability, flexibility, creativity and organisation
- Ability to differentiate teaching that enhances student outcomes
- Work closely with our Library Technician and Head of Campus
- Approved to teach in the NSW Education with an emphasis on high quality teaching and learning practices
- Any other role as requested by the Principal or his delegate
