ACARA Item Trial

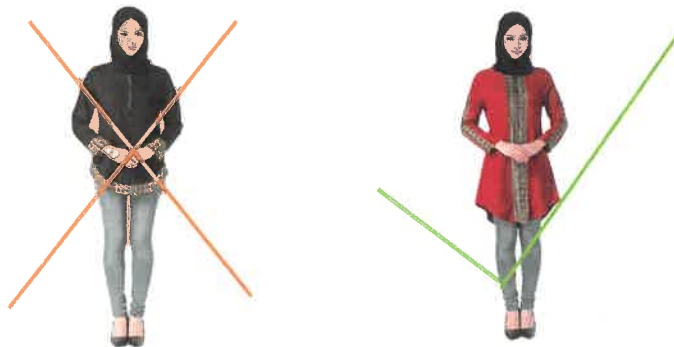
